3. <u>Mayor Szymanski</u> – Submits a copy of the letter received from Town of Hamburg Supervisor James M. Shaw regarding the repaying of Willet Road.

- 4. <u>Director of Development</u> Requests the City Council remove from the table communication # 8 from the May 21, 2018 regular meeting. This item pertains to the application for Community Development Block Grant Smart Growth Funds in the amount of \$325,000.00, with a cash match of \$32,500.00.
- 5. <u>City Assessor</u> Recommends the City Council approve the sale of 76 Holland Avenue to Fadl A. Faadel in the amount of \$4,500.00. This property is currently vacant and in poor condition. The buyer would bring the property into code compliance within 12 months of title transfer.
- 6. <u>City Assessor</u> Recommends the City Council <u>NOT</u> approve the sale of 174 & 178 Well Street to Wardell M. Spates in the amount of \$500.00. The recommendation of this office is \$1,000.00, which has been conveyed to the purchaser.
- 7. <u>City Assessor</u> Recommends the City Council approve the sale of 297 Ridge Road to Stanley C. Tyrpak in the amount of \$1,000.00. This is a vacant parcel that would be utilized for constructing a garage at the rear of the property and cleaning up the remaining parcel. All improvements would be subject to zoning and planning board approval if necessary.
- 8. <u>City Attorney</u> Advises the City Council that pursuant to section 3.2 of the City Charter, the Council must appoint a person to the vacancy created by the resignation of Council President Lewis, effective May 31, 2018.

Sports Club INC.</u> – Requests City Council approve the use of Veterans Stadium every Saturday, from June 23rd until July 28th, 2018, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. for hosting the LA Sports Club Flag Football Showcase, with child participants between the ages of 5-15 years old. Each child will be required to pay a donation
