An Ordinance amending Chapter 165, Peace and Good Order, of the City of Lackawanna Municipal Code, specifically by adding Section 165-11, sub-sections (A) through (F), False Alarms. This added section defines a False Alarm (A, B, C & D) and attaches sub-section (E) - Penalties:

- 1) There is no charge for the first two false alarms within a calendar year; however, the following charges will be applicable for subsequent false alarms in a calendar year.
  - a. Third, fourth or fifth false alarm: \$50.00 each
  - b. Sixth false alarm: \$100.00 each
  - c. Seventh and each false alarm thereafter: \$500.00 each
