Approval of Minutes: of the regular meeting of September 9, 2019

Departmental Reports:

1. **City Treasurer** – Total Receipts Deposited to the General Fund for the month of August 2019
2. **City Comptroller-** A/P Check Listing #4, dated September 5, 2019
3. **City Comptroller-** A/P Check Listing #5, dated September 12, 2019

Communications from Department/Division Heads:

4. **City Attorney-** Requests the City Council approve an ordinance to Rescind & Replace Chapter 190, Solid Waste

(A) Garbage and non-recyclable refuse and rubbish shall be placed in sealed garbage bags, prior to being stored in totes. Refuse or rubbish which is not in sealed garbage bags, shall not be collected by the City and the owner, occupants or any person having the care and control of the lot or land shall be charged with a violation. The lid must be completely closed and the tote shall not exceed 150 pounds when filled.
5. **Animal Control Officer** –Requests that no changes be made to Chapter 66-16- number of dogs permitted at a property address. The number of dogs unlicensed per household in the City has been an ongoing problem for years.

Communications from Citizens:

6. **Clark Patterson Lee Engineering** - Reviewed the bids and qualifications of the low bidder and recommends the City Council award the roofing contract, for 2838 South Park Avenue (new City Hall), to Progressive Roofing Inc, for the bid of \$386,000. The bid value is 2% less than the anticipated construction cost based on an independent estimate.
7. **Clark Patterson Lee Engineering-** Reviewed the bids and qualifications of the low bidder and recommends the City Council award the contract for Asbestos Abatement, for 2838 South Park Avenue (new City Hall), to Mark Cerrone Inc., for the bid of \$213,900. The bid value is 11% less than the anticipated construction cost based on an independent estimate.
8. **Justin Rooney-Erie County Board of Elections-** Informs the City Council of the Poll Locations available for the early voting which will begin Saturday, October 26 and continue through Sunday, November 3, 2019. Voters **may** vote at any location, **during Early Voting** days only, regardless of where they reside.

9. **Erik Piechowicz**- Requests the City Council address the incident involving the Animal Control Office and the dog that was killed in Holy Cross Cemetery

10. **George Halsey**- Submits a petition to the City Council, from the residents of the First Ward, requesting help resolving the issue of the perfuse odor emitting from the garbage trucks
