## A Message from Mayor Annette Iafallo .... Lackawanna Festival, Weather Alert, and Covid-19 Testing

Greetings to all,

I have a few short updates to share:

2020 LACKAWANNA FESTIVAL – due to ongoing concerns related to the Covid-19 pandemic, our festival scheduled for June 19-21 is cancelled. This difficult, but necessary decision was made to ensure the safety of our City residents, visitors and festival vendors. The Lackawanna Festival will return better than ever in the summer of 2021.

HIGH WIND WARNING – the National Weather Service has issued a high wind warning from 10 a.m. Monday, April 13 through 2 a.m. Tuesday, April 14. Wind gusts up to 70 mph may be experienced throughout Erie County and surrounding areas during this time. Please refer to local weather reports for any changes to this wind warning.

Regular garbage/recycle pickup will continue on our modified pickup schedule (morning for garbage and 4 p.m. for recycle). Please secure all loose recyclable materials in clear plastic bags or closed top boxes before placing in your recycling tote or bin/can marked X. If you have minimal recycling this week, please consider holding it until next week if possible.

COVID-19 TESTING IN ERIE COUNTY – on April 10, Erie County announced updated testing protocol – including no longer requiring a health care provider referral to initiate a Covid-19 test and testing priority for several high risk persons.
