- 2. <u>City Comptroller</u> Requests City Council approve the attached budget ordinance increasing the salary of the Police Chief to \$95,000.00 for the remaining portion of year.
  - (A) An ordinance amending the 2019-2020 budget ordinance adopted June 13, 2019 by increasing the salary of the Police Chief to \$95,000.00 for account A.3120.101 Personal Services, sub-section Police Chief, adding \$5,178.00 to budget code A3120.101 Police Department Personal Services and appropriating \$5,178.00 from budget code A.3120.105 Paid Holidays.
- 3. <u>City Comptroller</u> Requests City Council approve the attached budget ordinance to transfer funds to cover the budget differences which resulted from the contract negotiations of the CSEA Union Contract.
