## COMPLETING THE 2020 CENSUS

The census started in early March and so far, 59\% of Lackawanna residents have responded. In the coming weeks we need to work on getting our community response rate up to $100 \%$.

Achieving 100\% response to the census is important for helping Lackawanna receive appropriate funding for vital community services and projects including school lunch, medical and health programs, community/senior centers, and road construction/repairs, among others.

Visit www. 2020census.gov for instructions on how to complete the census online, by phone or mail. The survey takes only a few minutes to complete.
