A Message from Mayor Annette Iafallo – Rescheduled Bulk Trash Pickup Dates

The four bulk trash pickup dates postponed from the week of March 22 due to a Covid-19 outbreak in the DPW are being rescheduled over the next two weeks.

Please review the following schedule carefully:

- If your regular garbage day is Tuesday or Wednesday, your rescheduled bulk pickup is Tuesday, April 6 or Wednesday, April 7.*
- If your regular garbage day is Thursday or Friday, your rescheduled bulk pickup is Thursday, April 15 or Friday, April 16.*
- There is no rescheduled bulk pickup date for those whose regular garbage day is Monday as that pickup was completed before the postponement.*

In addition, the week of April 5 is 'one bulk item week' on your regular garbage day.

Please remember that bulk trash can't exceed one cubic yard of debris – with a maximum of five bulk items and no construction, shed, deck or fencing material is allowed in bulk trash. If you need to dispose of more than one cubic yard of debris or other non-bulk materials you will need to arrange for a commercial dumpster pickup.

We are grateful that our DPW workers impacted by Covid-19 have recovered. And thanks to everyone for their patience these past few weeks.
