City of Lackawanna to Conduct Pop-Up Covid-19 Vaccine Clinic on Wednesday, April 7 with Rite Aid and Erie County Senior Services

Lackawanna, N.Y. – The City of Lackawanna is partnering with Rite Aid Pharmacy and Erie County Senior Services to provide Covid-19 vaccinations to Lackawanna residents age 16 and older at a pop-up clinic to be held today, Wednesday April 7, 2021 from 9AM to 9PM at the Lackawanna Senior Center, 230 Martin Road.

Covid-19 vaccines are being provided to over 280 residents who pre-registered for the clinic. Rite Aid is providing the Pfizer vaccine for this pop-up clinic, which requires two doses.
