

Date: February 2, 2022

I'm requesting approval from this honorable body to allow me to initiate design and estimating work related to installing a full traffic signal with cross-walk on Ridge Road at Steelawanna Avenue.

In 2021, the City of Lackawanna received a \$250,000 Pedestrian & Vehicle Safety Grant from Erie County Legislator John Gilmour, which will be used toward this project. These funds were received by our Comptroller's office last year.

As you are aware, the traffic signals that once existed along Ridge Road in the First Ward were gradually removed in the years after the Bethlehem Steel Plant closed. As a result, it is very difficult for residents living in neighborhoods off the south-side of Ridge Road to cross safely.

With the increase in vehicle traffic now occurring on Ridge Road from the growing Renaissance Commerce Park, other thriving local businesses in the area including Quikrete and Al Sultan Restaurant & Bakery and the county's future plans to add an entry point for the commerce park at Ridge Road, a traffic signal at Ridge Road at Steelawanna Avenue is an absolute necessity.

With the ongoing supply chain issues impacting the country, it may take several months before the parts to assemble the traffic light are available. Thus, it's important that we begin the design and estimating phases. With your approval I can have DPW Commissioner DeSantis begin that work immediately.

# STANDARD INSURANCE PROVISIONS FOR

# MOWING AND LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE CONTRACTORS

The Contractor shall furnish insurance listed below. Insurance shall be placed with insurance carriers permitted to do business in New York State with a Best's Insurance Rating of A or better, acceptable to the City of Lackawanna. Contractor shall maintain this insurance at all times during performance of this contract. In addition, if insurance is written on a "claims-made" basis, such insurance shall be maintained by Contractor for a minimum period of three years after the completion of the contract. Contractor may elect to extend the discovery period under the existing policy for not less than three years.

Contractors shall require all subcontractors to the extent such are permitted, to furnish insurance listed below. Subcontractors shall maintain this insurance at all times during the performance of subcontractors' services. In addition, if insurance is written on a "claims-made" basis, such insurance shall be maintained by subcontractors for a minimum period of three years after the completion of their services. Subcontractors may elect to extend the discovery period under the existing policy for not less than three years.

Contractor shall have the City of Lackawanna named as an additional insured under the insurance policies required below and shall provide a certificate of insurance naming the City of Lackawanna as an additional insured.

# Insurance Required (Please refer to the vendor limit guidelines)

# Workers' Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance-

Contractor or subcontractor shall maintain Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance of the state in which the services are to be performed.

- (a) A Contractor or subcontractor that is a legally permitted and qualified self-insurer in the state in which services are to be performed, may furnish proof that it is such self-insurer in lieu of submitting proof of insurance.
- (b) Contractor shall determine if the work to be performed under this contract requires coverage by any Federal Compensation statutes including, but not limited to, the Longshoremen's and Harbor Workers' Compensation Act or Jones Act and provide such coverage.
- (c) The Commercial Umbrella and/or Employers' Liability limits must be in an amount not less than for each accident included in the workers' compensation policy or separately obtained in those states that do not provide employer liability under the workers' compensation policy.

Commercial General and Umbrella Liability Insurance - Commercial general and umbrella liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence.

Business Automobile and Commercial Liability Insurance - Business automobile and commercial liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence.

### REPORT TO THE BOARD

January 12, 2022

Honorable Mayor and Members of the City Council City of Lackawanna, New York:

We have audited the financial statements of the governmental activities, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the City of Lackawanna, New York (the City) for the year ended July 31, 2021 and have issued our report thereon dated January 12, 2022. Professional standards requires that we provide you with information about our responsibilities under auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and Government Auditing Standards, as well as certain information related to the planned scope and timing of our audit. We have communicated such information in our engagement letter. Professional standards also require that we communicate to you the following information related to our audit.

### Significant Accounting Policies

Management is responsible for the selection and use of appropriate accounting policies. Significant accounting policies used by the City are described in note 1 to the financial statements. As described in note 19 to the financial statements, the City adopted Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Statement No. 84 - "Fiduciary Activities," during the year ended July 31, 2021. We noted no transactions entered into by the City during the year for which there is a lack of authoritative guidance or consensus. All significant transactions have been recognized in the financial statements in the proper period.

### Accounting Estimates

Accounting estimates are an integral part of the financial statements prepared by management and are based on management's knowledge and experience about past and current events and assumptions about future events. Certain accounting estimates are particularly sensitive because of their significance to the financial statements and because of the possibility that future events affecting them may differ significantly from those expected.

For the year ended July 31, 2021, we evaluated the key factors and assumptions used by management in determining that accounting estimates were reasonable in relation to the financial statements taken as a whole.

### Significant Disclosures

The financial statement disclosures are neutral, consistent and clear.

### Difficulties Encountered in Performing the Audit

We encountered no difficulties in dealing with management in performing and completing our audit.

### Corrected and Uncorrected Misstatements

Professional standards require us to accumulate all misstatements identified during the audit other than those that are clearly trivial, and communicate them to the appropriate level of management. Management has corrected all such misstatements. In addition, none of the misstatements detected as a result of audit procedures and corrected by management were material, either individually or in the aggregate, to each opinion unit's financial statements taken as a whole.

### Disagreements with Management

For purposes of this report, professional standards define a disagreement with management as a financial accounting, reporting, or auditing matter, whether or not resolved to our satisfaction that could be significant to the financial statements or the auditors' report. We are pleased to report that no such disagreements arose during the course of the audit.

### **Management Representations**

We have requested certain representations from management that are included in the management representation letter.

### Management Consultations with Other Independent Accountants

In some cases, management may decide to consult with other accountants about auditing and accounting matters similar to obtaining a "second opinion" on certain situations. If a consultation involves application of an accounting principle to the City's financial statements or a determination of the type of auditors' opinion that may be expressed on those statements, our professional standards require the consulting accountant to check with us to determine that the consultant has all the relevant facts. To our knowledge, there were no such consultations with other accountants.

### Other Audit Findings or Issues

We generally discuss a variety of matters, including the application of accounting principles and auditing standards, with management prior to being engaged as auditors. However, these discussions occurred in the normal course of our professional relationship and our responses were not a condition to our retention.

### Other Matters

We applied certain limited procedures to management's discussion and analysis, the schedule of revenue, expenditures and changes in fund balance - budget and actual - general fund, the schedule of City's proportionate share of the net pension liability, the schedule of City's pension contributions and the schedule of changes in the City's total OPEB liability and related ratios, which are required supplementary information (RSI) that supplements the basic financial statements. Our procedures consisted of inquiries of management regarding the methods of preparing the information and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to our inquires, the basic financial statements, and other knowledge we obtained during our audit of the basic financial statements. We did not audit the RSI and do not express an opinion or provide any assurance on the RSI.

This information is intended solely for the use of the City Council and management of the City and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.
