2. <u>Mayor Iafallo</u> – Requests the City Council approve a traffic study for the intersection of Abbott and Ridge Road at an estimated cost between \$15,000.00 and \$20,000.00.

- 3. <u>Director of Recreation</u> Requests the City Council approve the use of Veteran's Stadium by Kodex Elite Sports Training for Flag Football games and practices as indicated in their included schedule between August 1 and October 24, 2022. Proof of insurance attached.
- 4. <u>Director of Recreation</u> Requests the City Council approve the use of Veteran's Stadium by the Church of God Restoration and Mercy House for the church event that was conditionally approved by your honorable body at the October 4, 2021 City Council meeting.
