The City of Lackawanna is an exempt organization under the Tax Law and is exempt from payment of Sales and Compensating Use Taxes on materials which are to be incorporated into the project and which are to be separately sold by the Contractor to the Owner prior to the incorporation into the project, pursuant to the provision of the contract. <u>These taxes are not to be included with the bid.</u>

Each bid must be accompanied by a non-collusive certification and a certified check from the bidder in the amount of 5% of the bid, made payable to the owner, or an acceptable bid bond in the amount of 5% of the bid. Certified checks or bid bonds from unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the owner and accepted bidder have executed a contract.
