## **Lackawanna City Hall Summer Hours Begin Wednesday, July 6<sup>th</sup>**

**LACKAWANNA, N.Y.** (Tuesday, July 5, 2022) – The City of Lackawanna today announced that operating hours for City Hall are being adjusted to a summer schedule effective tomorrow.

Starting Wednesday, July 6<sup>th</sup> and continuing through Wednesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>, Lackawanna City Hall will be open weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. except for Wednesday during the summer schedule when the hours will be 9:00 a.m. to Noon.

The City Clerk's and Treasurer's offices will continue to close at 4:00 p.m. on weekdays except for each Wednesday during the summer schedule when those offices will close at 11:45 a.m.

Questions about the summer schedule or other business at city hall can be directed to the appropriate department. A city hall directory is posted on the home page of the City of Lackawanna website at [www.lackawannany.gov](http://www.lackawannany.gov).

Mayor Annette Iafallo today announced that both Lackawanna City Hall and the city's Senior Center located at 230 Martin Road will be fully reopened to the public starting Tuesday, June 1, 2021.

Since mid-November of 2020, in compliance with NYS Covid-19 Executive Orders, the City of Lackawanna has conducted public business at City Hall by appointment only and closed its Senior Center to all activities except the Meals on Wheels program.

Starting on Tuesday, June 1:

- **Lackawanna City Hall** will be open Monday - Friday from 9:00AM to 4:30PM, except for the City Clerk's and Treasurer's offices which close at 4:00PM. No appointment is necessary.

Following practices recently adopted by Erie County government, all visitors to Lackawanna City Hall will be required to wear protective face masks and follow social distancing protocols while in the building regardless of Covid-19 vaccination status.

- **The Lackawanna Senior Center** will resume all meal, activity and van services Monday - Friday from 9:00AM to 5:00PM. The facility is not open on weekends.

Lackawanna Senior Center participants will be asked for proof of Covid-19 vaccination. Partially and non-vaccinated participants must wear protective face masks and comply with social distancing protocols. Residents can call 827-6669 with senior center questions on/after June 1.

“I want to thank Lackawanna residents for their patience and cooperation during the long period of restricted activity in these city buildings due to the pandemic,” said Mayor lafallo. “While we still need to be cautious, there is finally some light at the end of the tunnel and we look forward to being fully open for business at both locations.”
