A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR IAFALLO - STATE OF EMERGENCY & TRAVEL ADVISORY AS OF DECEMBER 23, 2022 (UPDATED AS OF 9AM)

The winter snow storm projected to hit the area is progressing faster than anticipated according to the National Weather Service.

As a result, under New York State Executive Law, I am declaring State of Emergency for the City of Lackawanna effective immediately.

Erie County and the City of Buffalo have also taken such action.

In addition, A COUNTY-WIDE TRAVEL BAN INCLUDING LACKAWANNA WILL TAKE EFFECT AT 9:30 AM TODAY, DECEMBER 23RD

Please take this opportunity to prepare - alternate parking rules are still in effect so please make sure your vehicle is parked on the correct side of the road and if available, move it into a driveway or nearby parking.

For those who had their garbage and recycling picked up today, please bring your tote and recycling bins into a secure storage area as soon as possible to avoid them blowing around neighborhood streets.
