**A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR ANNETTE IAFALLO – CITY HALL & SENIOR CENTER CLOSED
FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 18TH / TRAVEL ADVISORY IN EFFECT.**

Given the winter storm projected for the Buffalo-Metro area starting this evening, Thursday November 17th and continuing through the weekend, we are implementing the following actions:

- A travel advisory is in effect in Lackawanna – no unnecessary travel is advised, especially later this evening and into Friday**
- Lackawanna City Hall will be closed on Friday, November 18th**
- The Lackawanna Senior Center will also be closed on Friday, November 18th EXCEPT for the Meals on Wheels Program.**

Given forecasted snow totals of between 2 to 4 feet, I'm asking all residents to do their best to help in the following ways:

- Keep sidewalks, walkways and fire hydrants near your property clear and passable in the event of an emergency where police, fire and EMT personnel need to respond,**
- If available, please park cars in your driveway or adhere to alternate street parking rules so our plows can clear the roads effectively and first responder vehicles can pass,**
- Check on any elderly family and friends living nearby, and assist where needed.**

Starting today at 4:00 p.m. and continuing through Sunday, the Lackawanna DPW will be fully staffed and equipped to address the storm's impact throughout our city. Clearing main roads will be the first priority followed by secondary roads and side streets.
