A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR ANNETTE IAFALLO – STORM UPDATES REGARDING CITY HALL, SENIOR CENTER, GARBAGE PICK-UP, ALTERNATIVE PARKING & FIRE HYDRANT CLEARING

Lackawanna remains in a state of emergency however, City Hall will reopen for all business as of 9:00 AM on Wednesday, November 23rd.

The Senior Center will be open on November 23rd for the Meals on Wheels Program only.

And alternate parking will resume effective at 4:00 PM, also on November 23rd

Garbage pickup will be suspended on Wednesday, November 23rd and Thursday, November 24th. Pickup will resume on Friday, November 25th for those whose regular pickup day is Friday:

- Pickup starting on November 25th will be for trash and recycling only.
- There will be NO single item bulk pickup.
- Please bag garbage in your tote and secure all recycling materials.
- If you have more garbage than can fit in a tote, put it at the curb in sturdy trash bags with your tote (please – no paper or flimsy plastic bags).
- Make sure your tote is free from snow. DPW crews will not dig out any buried totes.

The Fire Department is working in all four wards clearing hydrants. If you are able to help clear a hydrant near your home, we would appreciate your assistance.
