A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR ANNETTE IAFALLO – REGARDING SNOW REMOVAL ON RIDGE ROAD, ABBOTT ROAD, SOUTH PARK, AND ELECTRIC AVENUE

The City of Lackawanna is concerned with the public safety as it relates to snow deposits and removal.

It is a violation of Municipal Code to allow snow or ice to accumulate on sidewalks and pedestrian walkways. It

is also a violation to deposit snow on city streets or sidewalks. Please safeguard that snow is not piled in such a

manner as to obstruct the vision of pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

§ 194-20 Depositing snow or ice upon streets or sidewalks.

It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or deposit, or to permit or cause to be thrown or deposited, upon the

sidewalks or streets of the City any snow or ice which has fallen or accumulated on the private property side of

the sidewalk line or in those locations where a building line has been established on the private property side of

such building line.

§ 194-21 Removal of snow and ice.

It shall be the duty of every owner or occupant of any premises fronting on any public street or alley to remove

before 9:00 a.m. all snow and ice which may have fallen upon the sidewalk in front of said premises. In case said

sidewalk is not paved its full width, it shall be necessary to remove such snow or ice only from a space three feet

in width.

Please ensure a safe environment for our citizens by making sure sidewalks are clear and snow is removed in a
