Project Impact

- Flexlume has relocated its entire 20-person operation from a long-time City of Buffalo location at 1464 Main Street to its new Lackawanna facility, with plans to add an additional 10 jobs in the near future.
- Flexlume's project is part of over \$130 million in new development projects underway or completed in Lackawanna since 2020 and the first light manufacturing/office project constructed in the city outside of the Erie County-led Renaissance Commerce Park footprint.

Travel/Site Notes – Flexlume's new Lackawanna facility is located at the end of Albright Court, which is off Dona St. east of Renaissance Commerce Park:

- From Downtown Buffalo: take the Skyway (NYS Rt. 5) southbound to Dona St. Make a left onto Dona St. and then the first left onto Albright Court.
- From Ridge Road traveling west: turn left onto Ingham Avenue. Take Ingham Ave. south until it turns into Dona St. Continue west on Dona Street toward NYS Route 5. Albright Court is the second street on the right (Wilmuth is the first).
