## Lackawanna Announces Modified Services Schedule for April 8 Due to Solar Eclipse

Lackawanna, N.Y. (March 27, 2024) – Mayor Annette Iafallo today announced a modified services schedule will be implemented in the city of Lackawanna on Monday, April 8, 2024 due to the solar eclipse.

On that day, the following Lackawanna municipal buildings will close at Noon:

- City Hall, 714 Ridge Road all departments except Fire and Police.
- Senior Center, 230 Martin Road all activities including the dine-in lunch, frozen meal pickup, and Meals on Wheels programs.
- Public Works Department, Reddon Street all services.

*In addition, the city's first bulk trash week of 2024 set to begin on April 8 is being modified*; bulk pickups originally scheduled for April 8 will now occur on Monday, April 15, as the city's transfer station partner is closed due to the eclipse.

The eclipse will have no impact on the city's bulk pickup schedule for Tuesday, April 9 through Friday, April 12, nor its regular garbage/recycling pickup schedule for the week of April 8.
