At the request of Council, a Proposal from Sapphire Business Systems, Inc dated November 2nd, 2023, was supplied at the November 20th, 2023, Council Meeting. A copy of the Certification of Action Taken at Council Meeting and its attachments are attached herewith for your reference.

The services outlined in the attached document are necessary to reconcile software and procedural-related deficiencies. The reconciliation of data from August, 2022 through April, 2023 is complete. Please be advised that 132 hours of the 150 estimated hours have been utilized through February 17th, 2024, as itemized on the attached invoice dated February 19th, 2024.

The hours set forth in the Proposal dated November 2nd were an estimate. In order to complete the process for the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year, it is estimated that 32 additional hours will be necessary to complete the reconciliation for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year.
