- 3. <u>City Comptroller</u> Requests City Council approve an ordinance to increase the funds budgeted to the "Equipment" budget line, as requested by Sr. Forman, Dan Geercken. The purpose is to purchase a CAT Snowblower attachment; cost \$78,934.00.
 - 3(A) An ordinance amending the 2023-2024 Budget Ordinances increasing the "Equipment" budget line in the amount of \$78,934.00 to purchase a CAT Snowblower attachment. This amount will be transferred from the "Contingent Account" budget line.
- 4. <u>Director of Parks and Recreation</u> Requests City Council approve the use of Veterans Stadium by Lackawanna Little Loop Football on June 22, 23, 24, 2024 from 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Insurance is attached.
- 5. <u>City Attorney and Director of Development & Marketing:</u> Requests the City Council approve an ordinance amending Section 75 of the City Code (Building Code Admin.). This is needed for Chapter 75 to procedurally concur with the new Cannabis Ordinance (Chapter 93).
 - 5(A) An ordinance amending Section 75-20 APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL USE PERMIT, Section 75-21 REFERRAL OF APPLICATIONS TO ZONING AND PLANNING BOARDS and Section 75-23 REVOCATION OF SPECIAL PERMITS; all part of Chapter 75 of the Municipal Code.
- 6. Fire Chief Requests the City Council approve the purchase of a used fire engine to replace Engine 33; a 1996 Spartan pumper. The cost of the used fire engine is in the amount of \$20,000 and will be purchased from St. Johnsburg Fire Company. Funds are available in the "Emergency Equipment" budget line. The Fire Chief is also requesting to sell Engine 33 and if it cannot be sold, to scrap the fire engine.

- 7. <u>Sr. Foreman of Public Works</u> Requests the City Council approve the purchase of a new Kubota Tractor with grass cutting deck from Monroe Tractor Co. (New York State Contract, no bid required). The cost is \$31,420.50. Funds will be taken from the "Equipment" budget line.
