Lackawanna Implements New Parking Ordinance Governing Truck and Overnight Parking on Fuhrmann Boulevard

Lackawanna, New York. (Friday, May 31, 2024) The city of Lackawanna has announced a new parking ordinance governing tractor-trailer and overnight parking on an approximately one-third of a mile stretch of Fuhrmann Boulevard from Ridge Road, north to the Buffalo City line.

The new parking ordinance eliminates the following on both the west and east sides of the road:

- Overnight parking between 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Tractor-trailer / commercial vehicle parking at any time.

This section of Fuhrmann Boulevard at Ridge Road within the city limits is adjacent to the new Renaissance Commerce Park emerging on the former Bethlehem Steel Plant site and serves as a main entry point for Port of Buffalo operations.

‘This important section of commercial roadway had no established and posted parking restrictions and as a result, had become an informal truck stop and overnight parking destination,’ said Charles Clark, Lackawanna Director of Marketing & Public Information. ‘This situation created a safety hazzard for those who live and work nearby, as well as the city’s public works and public safety employees. This ordinance will help restore safe and orderly road conditions to this area of our city’s First Ward’

The city’s new parking ordinance, unanimously passed by the Lackawanna City Council at their May 20, 2024 business meeting, takes effect immediately. Appropriate signage has been posted along the roadway as of today.
