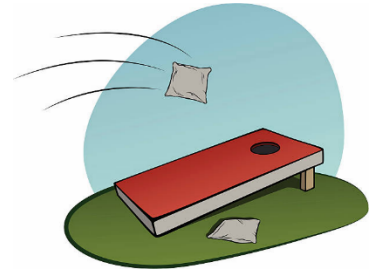

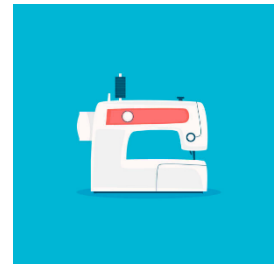

The City of Lackawanna will be accepting property tax exemption applications and copies of required documents for 2025 property tax bills on Wednesday, October 2 and Wednesday, October 9, 2024 at the Senior Center, 230 Martin Road, from Noon-3:00 PM both days.

This session is for the **following exemptions only**:

- First time or renewal of Senior and Disability Exemptions for those age 65 and older, whose income is below \$29,899.
- First time Enhanced Star, for those age 65 and older whose income is below \$98,700
- First time Veterans Exemption

PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU ALREADY RECEIVE VETERAN'S OR ENHANCED STAR EXEMPTIONS, YOU DO NOT NEED TO RE-APPLY

Those who are exemption eligible and plan to attend the event are asked to bring **copies** of your documentation as we will not have the ability to make copies at the event. You will need:

- Photo ID showing proof of age
- 2023 Federal Income Tax filing
- OR, if you do not file income taxes, copies of the following 1099 documents for 2023:
 - Social Security
 - Retirement
 - Pension
 - Interest Statements
 - IRA Distributions
