- * Van will travel to Mercy Hospital and Mercy Ambulatory Center.
- * All transportation appointments must be scheduled and approved **THREE**Days in advance by calling: 827-6669.
- * First pickup is at 9:15 am.
- * Last incoming pick up is at 4:15 pm.
- * No medical van Pickups on Friday mornings from 9:00 am 1:00 pm.
- * EVERY FRIDAY morning this van will transport seniors to Tops, Wegmans or Market in the Square. (These locations will be alternated).

- Photo ID showing proof of age
- 2023 Federal Income Tax filing
- OR, if you do not file income taxes, copies of the following 1099 documents for 2023:
- Social Security
- Retirement
- Pension
- Interest Statements
- IRA Distributions
