Separate sealed Bids for the City of Lackawanna, Steelawanna Avenue and Ridge Road Intersection Traffic Signal Construction project will be received by the City Clerk, City Hall – Room 215, 714 Ridge Road, Lackawanna, NY 14218 until **10:45 a.m. (local time) on Wednesday, October 2, 2024** and then opened and read aloud at Council Chambers, 2nd floor, City Hall, at 11:00 a.m.

This project encompasses the installation of two traffic poles, compliant with NYSDOT standards and manufacturer specifications, complete with foundations and mast arms. New signal heads will be affixed to the mast arms. Three (3) ADA-compliant curb ramps and crosswalk striping across Ridge Road will be implemented, with new pedestrian poles installed at three (3) locations. Electrical infrastructure will be upgraded to support both traffic signals and pedestrian poles. Existing roadway striping within the intersection will be removed via micro-milling.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis.

The successful bidder must be an equal opportunity employer, must meet all appropriate State and Feder- al standards, and comply with all relevant governmental regulations.

This project is funded under the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (DASNY) and is subject to Exhibit F Non-Discrimination and Affirmative Action Policy for the Project included in the Contract Documents. The Contractor shall make good faith efforts to ensure that M/WBE share in the economic opportunities generated by DASNY's participation in projects or initiatives, and/or use of DASNY funds. Statement of Non-Collusion: Bidders on the contract are required to execute a non-collusive bidding certificate pursuant to Section 103d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

Security for Faithful Performance: The successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds written by firms licensed to do business in New York State, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amounts in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents.

Bidders shall comply with the Iran Divestment Act of 2012.

Sales and Use of Tax Exemptions: The City of Lackawanna is exempt from the payment of sales and compensation use taxes of the State of New York and of cities and counties on all materials, equipment, and supplies sold to the City of Lackawanna pursuant to this contract. Also exempt from such taxes are purchases by the Contractor and his/her Subcontractors of materials, equipment, and supplies to be sold to the City of Lackawanna pursuant to this contract, including tangible personal property to be incorporated in any structure, building, or other real property forming part of the project. These taxes are not to be included in the Bid.

All bids shall be binding for a period of forty-five (45) days after the bid opening date. The City of Lackawanna reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities therein.
