- \* Van will travel to Mercy Hospital and Mercy Ambulatory Center.
- \* All transportation appointments must be scheduled and approved **THREE**Days in advance by calling: 827-6669.
- \* First pickup is at 9:15 am.
- \* Last incoming pick up is at 4:15 pm.
- \* No medical van Pickups on Friday mornings from 9:00 am 1:00 pm.
- \* EVERY FRIDAY morning this van will transport seniors to Tops, Wegmans or Market in the Square. (These locations will be alternated).

### Winter arrives this year on December 21, 2024 at 4:19 a.m.

The **winter solstice** occurs when either of Earth's poles reaches its maximum tilt away from the Sun and is the day with the shortest period of daylight and longest night of the year. This happens twice yearly, once in each hemisphere (Northern and Southern). The sun is at its lowest daily maximum elevation in the sky. In the Northern Hemisphere, this occurs on December 21, December 22, or December 23.

Although the winter solstice itself lasts only a moment, the term also refers to the day on which it occurs and traditionally signifies the beginning of winter in the Northern Hemisphere. However, the days start to get longer and the sun will be slightly higher up.
