Transient or short-term rentals shall be prohibited in all districts of the City specifically: Single-Family Residential; Mixed Residential; Neighborhood Commercial; Central Business District; Regional Commercial; Mixed Commercial and Industrial; Industrial; Bethlehem Redevelopment Area; Open Space; McKinley Parkway Overlay; Seaway Trail Overlay; Smokes Creek Overlay and Planned Unit Development.
