DID YOU KNOW?

February, was named after the Latin term *februum*, which means "purification", via the purification ritual *Februa* held on February 15 (full moon) in the old lunar Roman calendar.

February is the second month of the year in the Julian and Gregorian calendars. The month has 28 days in common years and 29 in leap years, with the 29th day being called the *leap day*. February is the third and last month of meteorological winter in the Northern Hemisphere. In the Southern Hemisphere, February is the third and last month of meteorological summer (being the seasonal equivalent of what is August in the Northern Hemisphere).

Historical names for February include the Old English terms *Solmonath* (mud month) and Kalemonath (named for cabbage) as well as Charlemagne's designation Hornung. January and February were the last two months to be added to the Roman calendar, since the Romans originally considered winter a monthless period.

The zodiac signs of February are Aquarius (until February 18) and Pisces (February 19 onward). Its birth flowers are the violet, the common primrose, and the Iris. Its birthstone is the amethyst, which symbolizes piety, humility, spiritual wisdom, and sincerity.
