2. **Senior Foreman, Public Works** – Requests the City Council approve the ordinance transferring funds to maintain sanitation services. The budgeted allocation for Garbage & Refuse repairs and replacements has been exhausted.

2(A) An ordinance amending the 2025-2026 Budget Ordinance transferring \$60,000 to Budget Code “Repairs and Replacements” from Budget Code “Interfund Transfers”.
