8. Seeking approval for temporary detour in Lackawanna Sunday 7/19/26

This is Kevin Heffernan with GObike. We're planning ahead for Sunday July 19, 2026's **FINAL SKYRIDE**.

This year's event on Sunday, July 219 runs during the hours of 7AM - 12PM. The Skyway itself will close 6AM - 12PM.

The route of the ride (attached) is updated, but the route of planned traffic detour (attached) is exactly the same as 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025. The detour sends northbound cars on RT 5 to Ridge Rd and then Abbott Road.

Erie County has previously approved this as a viable and safe option to use as a detour.

We are formally requesting an official approval letter of this traffic diversion plan from the City of Lackawanna in order to be able to receive state permission to close the Skyway for the event. A letter or an email reply will be sufficient.
