

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION
SUBJECT TO A PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT, at a Special Meeting held on July 7, 2026, the Lackawanna City Council duly adopted the below resolution which is subject to permissive referendum pursuant to Section 1537 of the New York Real Property Tax Law. If after 45 days of the resolution's adoption by the City Council, no petition objecting to the resolution and requesting approval by the voters is filed with the City Clerk, any final agreement with Erie County will be submitted to the City Council for approval.

RESOLUTION NO. 8, 2026

WHEREAS, Section 1537 of the Real Property Tax Law ("Section 1537") provides that a city and a county shall have the power to enter into a joint service agreement for assessment services;

WHEREAS, Section 1537 further provides that no such agreement shall be submitted to the governing body of the city for approval unless at least forty-five days prior to such submission, the governing body shall have adopted a resolution, subject to a permissive referendum, authorizing the city to negotiate such agreement with the county; and

WHEREAS, the Lackawanna City Council deems it in the best interest of the City of Lackawanna to enter into negotiations with Erie County for the purposes of potentially entering into a joint service agreement for assessment services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the City of Lackawanna, via Mayor Iafallo or the Mayor's designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate with Erie County to enter into an eventual joint service agreement for assessment services; and

RESOLVED, that this Resolution be subject to a permissive referendum.

THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
